

New Boundary of Land Area Included in Agreed Order

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) and the Port of Seattle (Port) entered into an Agreed Order in April 2012, to clean up the Terminal 91 (T91) Site (Site) located at 2001 West Garfield Street, in Seattle Washington.

Recently, the Port sold a 5.4-acre parcel of land at T91, (shown in the figure below as the West Yard), to King County and the City of Seattle. At the time of the sale, a minor change to the Agreed Order took effect modifying the boundary of the Site to exclude the 5.4-acre parcel.

The sale will not affect the cleanup, as no cleanup was required for the West Yard, but it will change the boundary of the land subject to the Agreed Order. Public notice of the proposed removal of the parcel was sent out in January of 2012.

King County plans to use part of the land to construct an underground combined sewage overflow storage vault ("CSO Project"). The City of Seattle plans to use its part of the land to construct a new waterfront park.
