In keeping with the requirement of WAC 173-340-310(5), the department has determined the release associated with ERTS #641624 at the Site requires no further action at this time. A release of a hazardous substance has occurred, but in the department's judgment, does not pose a threat to human health or the environment.

May 30, 2013, a refueling tanker overfilled an Underground Storage Tank (UST). Approximately 300 gallons of unleaded gasoline was spilled with no product recovered.

Able Clean-up Technologies, Inc. was contracted to perform the cleanup activities. The cleanup report stated only soil was impacted by the release. The removal of contaminated soil began on May 31, 2013, and 96 tons of Petroleum Contaminated Soil (PCS) was disposed of at the Greater Wenatchee Landfill. Confirmational samples were collected and analyzed for Gasoline Range Organics (GRO), Benzene, Toluene, Ethylbenzene, & Xylenes (BTEX). No concentrations above MTCA Method A Cleanup Levels were present at the perimeters of the soil excavation.

Groundwater monitoring wells are currently installed to monitor a previous and separate release at the Site (CSID: 11391). The wells were inspected at the time of the release, and no free product was noted. The last groundwater monitoring event at the Site was performed 10/23/2013; nearly 5 months after this release. This lag time should have been sufficient for impacted groundwater, if any to reach the monitoring wells. No increased contaminant concentrations were noted.

This Department Decision and Recommendation should be reviewed and re-evaluated based on any new information about this Site.
