Enclosed is a copy of the legal description of the approximate area of concern at the subject site. Weyerhauser is still searching their records for the legal description of the land leased to Koppers Company. I apologize for taking so long to get this to you.

I have enclosed portions of environmental assessment which is the basis for listing Koppers Company as a potentially liable party. If you wish to have a complete copy of this report, I would recommend that you contact Mr. John Gross of Weyerhauser. If Mr. Gross cannot supply you with a copy, the Department of Ecology can forward a cpoy at a cost of \$0.20 per page.

I have also enclosed a copy of Washington's superfund law and the draft regulations. The Model Toxics Control Act was passed as a citizens initiative which became effective last March. The regulations I have enclosed are presently out for public comment. As such, there may be some changes to the enclosed.
