Announcing Draft EPA 2022 Construction General Permit Request for Clean Water Act Section 401 Certification

Proposed Permit

The United States Environmental Protection Agency requested Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) Clean Water Act (CWA) Section 401 certification on July 16, 2021 for the following draft permit:

• 2022 Construction General Permit

The draft 2022 Construction General Permit would authorize certain point source discharges from construction sites to waters of the United States. The permit is operated under the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) in Washington State.

Purpose of the Permit

The 2022 Construction General Permit would replace the existing 2017 permit once finalized. The existing permit was issued for a five-year term on February 16, 2017 and will expire on February 16, 2022. The draft 2022 Construction General Permit would authorize certain point source discharges from construction sites to waters of the United States.

Purpose of the 401 Certifications

Section 401 of the CWA provides that the federal government may not issue a permit relating to any activity which may result in any discharge into the navigable waters until a certification is granted or waived by the state in which the discharge originates, or will originate.

The state certification evaluates whether the discharge will comply with the applicable provisions of sections 301, 302, 306, and 307 of the CWA and appropriate requirements of state law. Ecology will review the draft permits pursuant to Section 401 of the CWA, and with applicable provisions of State water pollution control laws.
