Dear Kyle Lentz:

On January 6, 2021, the Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is to continue to commercially cultivate up to 4.77 acres of geoduck clams, and up to 1.72 acres of manila clams and pacific oysters for a total 6.49 acre cultivation area (all species) within an 8.79 acre project area.

The project site is located on tidelands within Totten Inlet of South Puget Sound, on parcel numbers: 220295000012, 220321180010, 220295000020, and 220295000021, at approximately 47.184351 North latitude / -122.9533494 West longitude near Shelton, Mason County, Washington; Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 2 West; WRIA 14, Kennedy-Goldsborough Watershed.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Chelsea Farms' determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
