Dear Duane Fagergren:

On April 23, 2021, the Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is to continue inter-tidal farming of Pacific and Olympia oysters and manila clams on approximately 2.0 acres of intertidal area between the -4.0 ft. MLLW up to +5.5 ft MLLW.

The project site is located on tidelands within Totten Inlet, on parcel number 31914-30-80850, adjacent to 481 SE Fagergren Road, near Shelton, Mason County, Washington; Section 14, Township 19 North, Range 3 West; WRIA 14, Kennedy-Goldsborough Watershed.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Calm Cove Oyster Company's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

## YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

• File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
