Dear Matthew Mateo:

Enclosed is an amendment to Water Quality Certification Order No. 13195, issued on March 28, 2016 and amended on July 22, 2020, for the above project. All other conditions of Water Quality Certification No. 13195 remain in effect.

The purpose of this amendment is to alter the authorized depth to a total depth of -58 ft. MLLW and the total volume to 59,195 cubic yards. The request submitted on May 21, 2021 also requested changes to the in-water work window. However, under Condition F1, the approved windows are identified by the most current HPA. A new HPA was submitted on June 30, 2021, so the in-water work windows do not require amending the 401 timing condition.

On March 28, 2016, the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a 401 Water Quality Certification to the Port of Seattle for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401). On July 22, 2020, Ecology issued the first amendment for the project.

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Ecology received a request on May 21, 2021 to increase the depth and volume of the project to match those originally included in the SEPA (-58 ft MLLW and 59,195 CY).

Order No. 13195 dated March 28, 2016 is hereby amended as follows:

I. Project Description which reads:

Rehabilitate exiting Terminal 5 wharf structure and dredge up to 29,800 cubic yards from the berth area in West Waterway between -47 amd -55 feet Mean Lower Low Water.

Is replaced with:

Rehabilitate exiting Terminal 5 wharf structure and dredge up to 51,195 cubic yards from the berth area in West Waterway between -47 amd -58 feet Mean Lower Low Water.

No other conditions or requirements of the above referenced Order are affected by this amendment.

Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amended Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amended Order.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do both of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
