Dear Edward Smith:

On April 30, 2021, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is for replacing approximately 3400 foot long section of the 14 inch petroleum products pipeline with a new approximately 3,670 foot long section of pipe placed in a new permanent easement that ranges from approximately 25 to 170 feet eastward and parallel to the existing pipeline easement east of Interstate 5. These improvements would be located in the cities of Fife and Milton and in unincorporated Pierce County in Washington.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Olympic Pipe Line LLC's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

## **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.

- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
