On March 17, 2021, the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a 401 Water Quality Certification to Wiegardt and Sons, Inc. for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401).

Ecology received a request on September 17, 2021, to make minor changes to the acreage of farmed Manila Clams and flip bag Pacific Oysters on their Section 401 Water Quality Certification.

Order No. 19736 dated March 17, 2021 is hereby amended as follows:

I. Paragraph 2, sentence 1, which reads:

This project proposes to continue operation on 359 acres of bottom Manila clam culture, 218 acres of on bottom oyster culture, and 20 acres suspended oyster flip bag culture.

Is replaced with:

This project proposes to continue operation on 369 acres of bottom Manila clam culture, 218 acres of on bottom oyster culture, and 10 acres suspended oyster flip bag culture.

No other conditions or requirements of the above referenced Order are affected by this amendment.

Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amended Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amended Order.
