On November 23, 2020, Zittel's Marina Inc. submitted a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP). On May 17, 2021, Zittel's Marina and Ecology agreed to stay the CZM until December 15, 2021.

This decision is for maintenance dredging and ~~disposal upland placement~~ of dredged material at the ~~Anderson Ketron DMMP open water disposal site applicant's facility~~. It also includes pile removal as mitigation. The project is located on the Baird Cove, Nisqually Reach of Puget Sound, Thurston County, Washington.

Pursuant to Section 307(c) (3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Zittel's Marina's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

#### **YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001 (2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
