On August 12, 2021, Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Woodin Creek, Clark County, Washington. On August 17, 2021, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to construct a residential development in seven construction phases. The development will include a 318-lot residential subdivision and a 180-unit apartment complex, associated parking, access roads, and stormwater detention facilities.

The project will directly impact 0.05 acres of Category 3 wetlands and indirectly impact 0.72 acres of Category 3 wetlands. To mitigate for impacts to wetlands, the Applicant will provide 0.44 acres of wetland enhancement and 0.63 acres of wetland buffer enhancement and will purchase 0.12 acres at Remy Consolidated Mitigation Site for the remaining 0.09 acres of indirect impacts that will not be mitigated on-site.

The project site is located at 18717 NE 122nd Avenue, Battle Ground, Clark County, Washington; SE Quarter, Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 2 East, within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 28 Salmon-Washougal Watershed.

With this Order, Ecology is granting Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Woodin Creek project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on August 12, 2021, and the following supporting documentation:

- 1. Final Mitigation Plan prepared by Ecological Land Services for Woodin Creek Subdivision LLC, revised on October 14, 2021.
- 2. E-mail letter to Ecology dated December 8, 2021, with an Addendum to the Final Mitigation Plan.
- 3. E-mail letter to Ecology dated August 16, 2021, with attached SWPP.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that

materially alter the project, Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

Special Conditions:

- 1. The Applicant shall submit any proposed changes to the Mitigation Plan via e-mail to Ecology's Headquarters Office, at fednotification@ecy.wa.gov with a copy to Lori.kingsbury@ecy.wa.gov for review and approval before implementing the changes.
- 2. The Applicant shall install a split-rail fence, or other wildlife-friendly barrier approved by Ecology, along the outer boundary of wetland buffers directly adjacent to lots and roads to limit intrusion, encroachment, and other impacts.
- 3. Signs to mark the area as a mitigation site shall be placed on the fence posts at the spacing intervals defined in the approved Mitigation Plan.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted to the Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC for the Woodin Creek project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. Order No. **20877** will remain valid for the duration of the associated DA permit. Woodin Creek Subdivision, LLC should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
