On December 3, 2021, The Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is for the proposed project from BDN, LLC to cultivate Pacific geoduck (Panopea generosa) at the following sites. The planting areas will be as follows: Site #1 (the former Washington Shellfish Site) 2.64 acres generally between approximately +2 ft. MLLW and a 5-meter (16.4 ft.) buffer of the established native eelgrass (Zostera marina) bed edge, located between approximately -1 MLLW and -2 MLLW. Site #2 (BDN Site) .28 acres, generally between approximately +2 ft. MLLW and a 5-meter (16.4 ft.) buffer of the established native eelgrass (Zostera marina) bed edge, located between approximately -1 MLLW and -2 MLLW. Site #3 (the former Mocean Site) .65 acres, generally between approximately +2 ft. MLLW and a 5-meter (16.4 ft.) buffer of the established native eelgrass (Zostera marina) bed edge, located between approximately -1 MLLW and -2 MLLW.

The project site is located on tidelands within Squamish Harbor, on parcel numbers: Site #1 (Former Washington Shellfish) 821334073, Site #2 BDN 821334011, Site #3 (Former Mocean) 821334079, adjacent to 1160-1254 Shine Road, near Port Ludlow, Jefferson County, Washington; Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 1 East; WRIA 17, Quilcene-Snow Watershed.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with BDN LLC Geoduck Farm's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

#### YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
