On February 2, 2022, Alexander Reed, LLC submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Northridge Park Division 2 project located in Snohomish County, Washington. The following processing dates are referenced below:

- On May 26, 2021, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) notified Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under Nationwide Permit #29, and an individual Section 401 is required.
- On March 3, 2022, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to construct a a 27 lot residential subdivision with associated infrastructure. The access road will cross a wetland and require installing a culvert to cross a Type N stream, which will impact 501 ft² of Category III wetland and 210 ft² of stream. This will be mitigated by purchasing 0.0149 credits at the Snohomish Basin mitigation bank.

The project site is located at 9220 76th Avenue NE in the City of Marysville, Snohomish County, Washington, Section 14, Township 30N., Range 5E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 7 Snohomish.

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting Alexander Reed, LLC's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Northridge Park Division 2 project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments that Ecology received on February 2, 2022, and the following supporting documentation:

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Alexander Reed, LLC must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Alexander Reed, LLC to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

Special Conditions:

- 1. The Alexander Reed, LLC shall mitigate wetland impacts as described in the Revised Mitigation Bank Use Plan for Northridge Park Division 2, as identified in Table 1 or as modified by this Order.
- 2. The Alexander Reed, LLC shall obtain a Statement of Sale from the Sponsor as documentation of purchase of 0.0149 credits for this impact project. The Project Proponent shall submit a copy of the Statement of Sale to Ecology within 60 days of receipt. Documentation from the Sponsor shall include:
 - a. Ecology's Order number,
 - b. Order issuance date,
 - c. Description of mitigation credits purchased,
 - d. Signatures from the Sponsor and the Applicant

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted to the Alexander Reed, LLC for the Northridge Park Division 2 project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. Order No. 21055 will remain valid for the duration of the associated DA permit. Alexander Reed, LLC should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

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YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
