On October 22, 2021, The Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

The project proposes to rehabilitate the Point Hudson Marina breakwater. Activities include breakwater replacement (removal of armor, creosote pilings and associated cables, and the timber walkway), dredging the navigational channel with upland disposal, habitat enhancement (rock habitat feature, placement of salvaged rock between the mooring buoy and the end of the south breakwater), and installation of the replacement breakwater (pile installation, armor stone placement, installation of eight foot wide walkway, and four foot thick shoreline armoring placed over two feet of bedding stone on top of geotextile fabric).

The project site is located at Point Hudson Marina, Port Townsend Bay, Jefferson County, Washington. Pursuant to Section 307(c) (3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Port of Port Townsend's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.
