Dear Kevin Bartoy:

On March 3, 2022, the Department of Ecology received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is for the replacement and upgrade of infrastructure at the Eagle Harbor Maintenance Facility, owned and operated by Washington State Ferries. This facility has six vessel slips for maintenance work designed to keep the entire ferry fleet running. An existing gangplank system at Slip F will be replaced with a new steel pile trestle and transfer span that has an adjustable mechanical system. The new infrastructure provides additional vehicle drive-on access allowing greater flexibility for doing maintenance work on ferries of all types. The project is located at 497 Harbor View Drive SE, on Bainbridge Island in Eagle Harbor, which is part of Puget Sound and is in Kitsap County, Washington.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Washington State Ferries' determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
