Dear Rick Stephens:

On January 19, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project.

This determination is to construct 195 linear feet (LF) of sheet piling bulkhead with backfill waterward of the HTL. The sheet piling bulkhead would be constructed up to 2 feet waterward of an existing damaged timber pile bulkhead. Up to 60 cubic yards of native fill material would be placed in the space between the existing and proposed bulkheads as backfill. If the required pile depth cannot be reached via vibratory hammer, up to 30 cubic yards would be excavated for trenching. All construction would take place from the beach with an excavator and small trucks, and all work would be conducted in the dry at low tide.

The project site is located at 3032 and 3034 South Camano Drive in Camano Island, Saratoga Passage, Island County, Washington, Section 9, Township 30 N., Range 3 E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 6 - Island. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with RS Construction Services, LLC's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08.

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing options below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology, in paper form, by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08.
