Lennar Northwest, LLC submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for Camas Heights Subdivision, Clark County, Washington. The following required processing dates are referenced below:

- On June 3, 2022, Lennar Northwest LLC, submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On November 17, 2022, Ecology received a request for Clean Water Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On December 2, 2022, and January 20, 2023, Lennar Northwest LLC submitted additional information, and the Department of Ecology (Ecology) considered the Request valid on this date.
- On November 29, 2022, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent an email notification to Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under Nationwide Permit No. 29 and requires an individual Section 401.
- On December 1, 2022, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to create 121 residential lots on a 37.2 acre parcel, that currently consists of a single-family residence, detached barn, milk house, outbuilding, and a pasture. Four category IV wetlands occur onsite, Wetlands A-D. Three of the wetlands, Wetlands B-D will be filled to provide area for housing. The fill will result in 0.27 acre of direct wetland impact. The largest wetland, Wetland A (1.44 acres) will not be directly impacted and will continue to provide connection to offsite wetlands.

Impacts to Wetlands B-D will be mitigated by the purchase of 0.23 bank credits (at a 0.85:1 ratio) from the Terrace Mitigation Bank.

The project site is located at 22630 NE 28th Street, Camas, Clark County, Washington, Section 21, Township 2N., Range 3E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 28, Salmon-Washougal.

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With this Order, Ecology is granting Lennar Northwest, LLC's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Camas Heights Subdivision project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on November 17, 2022, and the following supporting documentation:

- 1. Updated Camas Heights Subdivision Mitigation Bank Use Plan, submitted to Ecology on December 2, 2022, but dated November 2022.
- 2. Updated Wetland Rating Figures, submitted to Ecology on December 2, 2022.
- 3. Bank Credit Availability Verification letter, submitted to Ecology on January 20, 2023.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Lennar Northwest, LLC must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Lennar Northwest, LLC to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

Special Condition:

- 1. Lennar Northwest, LLC shall mitigate wetland impacts as described in the Mitigation Plan for Camas Heights Subdivision, prepared by AKS Engineering & Forestry, LLC, dated November 2022, (hereafter called the "Mitigation Plan") or as required by this Order.
 - Justification Alteration of water quality necessitates the use of mitigation as a method of controlling pollution. When adequate mitigation is provided, the impacts are not considered significant enough to water quality, at least in the long-term. The water quality standards, along with mitigation, protect wetlands as well as permitting some level of degradation where unavoidable or necessary.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 2. Prior to impacting Wetlands B-D, Lennar Northwest, LLC shall submit to Ecology documentation from the bank sponsor verifying the purchase of 0.23 wetland mitigation

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bank credits from the Terrace Wetland Mitigation Bank. This documentation must include the Ecology Order Number, Order issuance date, impact acreage, the amount of credits required by the Order, and date of credit purchase.

- Justification This condition is necessary to ensure the compensatory mitigation was actually provided by the bank.
- Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 3. Unless otherwise authorized by this WQC Order, Lennar Northwest, LLC shall complete the purchase of credits before impacting wetlands. Otherwise, Ecology may require Lennar Northwest, LLC to provide additional compensation to account for additional temporal loss of wetland functions.
 - Justification Mitigation that is not emplaced concurrent with impacts will result in degradation of existing beneficial uses of the wetlands affected by the proposed action through temporal loss of functions.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted to the Lennar Northwest, LLC for the Camas Heights Subdivision project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. Order No. **21601** will remain valid for the duration of the associated DA permit. Lennar Northwest, LLC should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21b.001(2). More information is available at https://eluho.wa.gov/content/11.

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

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- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing options below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology, in paper form, by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08.
