Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401), RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 and Chapter 173-201A WAC WQC ORDER No. 21451 Corps Reference No. NWS-2022-682 Eastview Village, Wetland A located in Snohomish County, Washington.

Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for Eastview Village, Snohomish County, Washington. The following required processing dates are referenced below:

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- On July 18, 2022, Pacific Ridge DRH, LLC submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On August 30, 2022, Pacific Ridge DRH, LLC submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On October 22, 2022, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent a permit notification to Ecology that indicated that they are processing the project under Nationwide Permit (NWP) No. 29.
- On October 31, 2022, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

The project proposes to re-develop the site of a previously constructed landfill with a mixed residential and commercial development. The proposed residential areas will include single-family residential lots and townhomes. The proposed project will impact a Category IV wetland (7,667 ft²). Offsite mitigation will compensate for these impacts through the purchase of 0.15 credits from the Snohomish Basin Mitigation Bank.

The project site is located at 8915 Cathcart Way, near the City of Snohomish, Snohomish County, Washington, Section 35, Township 28N., Range 5E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 7 – Snohomish River.

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Eastview Village project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on August 30, 2022, and the following supporting documentation: WQC Order No 21451, Corps No. NWS-2022-682 Aquatics 141844 April 18, 2023 Page 2 of 6

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

Special Conditions:

 Prior to impacting Wetland A, Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC shall submit to Ecology documentation from the bank sponsor verifying the purchase of 0.15 wetland mitigation bank credits from the Snohomish Basin Mitigation Bank. This documentation must include the Ecology WQC Order Number, WQC Order issuance date, impact acreage, the amount of credits required by the WQC Order, and date of credit purchase.

- Justification This condition is necessary to ensure the compensatory mitigation was actually provided by the bank.
- Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- Unless otherwise authorized by this WQC Order, Pacific Ridge DRH, LLC shall complete the purchase of credits before impacting wetlands. Otherwise, Ecology may require Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC to provide additional compensation to account for additional temporal loss of wetland functions.
 - Justification Mitigation that is not emplaced concurrent with impacts will result in degradation of existing beneficial uses of the wetlands affected by the proposed action through temporal loss of functions.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010 WAC.
- 3. The Project Proponent shall obtain and comply with the conditions of the Construction Stormwater General Permit (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System NPDES) issued for this project.
 - Justification Ecology must protect waters of the state from all discharges and potential discharges of pollution that can affect water quality to protect aquatic life and beneficial uses.
 - Citation Chapter 90.48 RCW, RCW 90.48.030, RCW 90.48.080, RCW 90.48.260, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-300 - 330, WAC 173-204-120, and WAC 173-225-010.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted to Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC for the Eastview Village project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. WQC Order No. 21451 will remain valid for the duration of the associated DA permit. Pacific Ridge – DRH, LLC should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21b.001(2). More information is available at https://eluho.wa.gov/content/11.

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing options below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology, in paper form, by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in RCW 43.21B and WAC 371-08.
