Dear William Perkins:

On April 13, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Perkins Family Farms LLC's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

This project includes the cultivation of 0.25 acres of Pacific and Kumamoto oysters within a 0.33-acre project area between tidal elevations +2.0 feet and -3.0 feet Mean Lower Low Water. Oysters are seeded by hand directly onto the substrate. No bags, lines, or posts are used. Harvest occurs by hand. The project area includes rocky sand beach with no visible vegetation other than seaweed. Access will be by boat or existing residential driveway.

The project site is located on tidelands within Pickering Passage, on parcel number 22009-12-90031, adjacent to 140 East Retreat Lane, near Shelton, Mason County, Washington; Section 9, Township 20 North, Range 2 West; WRIA 14, Kennedy-Goldsborough Watershed.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing options below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology, in paper form, by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.


