# In The Matter of Granting a Water Quality Certification to Sperry Ocean Dock pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401), RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 and Chapter 173-201A WAC

Sperry Ocean Dock submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Sperry Ocean Dock Pile Replacement, Pierce County, Washington. The following required processing dates are listed below:

- On 9/2/2022, the Sperry Ocean Dock submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On 10/3/2022, Ecology received a request for Clean Water Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On 10/31/2022, Sperry Ocean Dock submitted additional information, and the Department of Ecology (Ecology) considered the Request valid on this date.
- On 5/9/2023 the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent an email notification to Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under a Section 10 Letter of Permission (LOP) and requires an individual Section 401.
- On 5/17/2023, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to replace up to 129 creosote-treated timber piles (average 15-inch diameter) with 16-inch diameter steel piles filled with concrete and to resurface 5,900 SF of existing asphalt decking with concrete.

The project site is located within Commencement Bay at 611 North Schuster Parkway, Tacoma, Pierce County, Washington, Section 29, Township 21 N., Range 03 E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 12 – Chambers-Clover.

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting with conditions Sperry Ocean Dock's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Sperry Ocean Dock Pile Replacement project,

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provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on 10/3/2022, and the following supporting documentation:

1. E-mail letter to Ecology dated 10/31/2022, regarding the project's Water Quality Monitoring Plan, dated October 2022.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Sperry Ocean Dock must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Sperry Ocean Dock to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

## **Special Condition:**

1. Any work that causes distressed or dying fish or discharges of oil, fuel, or other chemicals into state waters or onto land with a potential for entry into state waters is prohibited<sup>1</sup>. If such work, conditions, or discharges occur, immediately notify<sup>2</sup> Ecology's Regional Spill Response Office at 360-407-6300 and the Washington State Department of Fish & Wildlife with the nature and details of the problem, any actions taken to correct the problem, and any proposed changes in operation to prevent further problems. You will also need to notify the Washington Emergency Management Division<sup>3</sup> at 1-800-258-5990, for spills to water only. This condition is necessary to prevent oil and other hazardous materials spills from causing environmental damage and to ensure compliance with water quality requirements. The sooner a spill is reported, the quicker it can be addressed, resulting in less harm.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted with conditions to the Sperry Ocean Dock for the Sperry Ocean Dock Pile Replacement project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. WQC Order No. **22288** will remain valid

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for the duration of the associated DA permit. Sperry Ocean Dock should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

# Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
