Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Cape George Marina Annual Maintenance project (Corps No. NWS-2023-379), within Discovery Bay and Strait of Juan de Fuca, Port Townsend, Jefferson County, Washington

Dear Martha Woodward:

On September 6, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Cape George Colony Club's (Martha Woodward) determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The proposed work includes annual maintenance dredge of up to 1000 cy of material from marina entrance for the next 10 years. It also includes dock repairs and repair/replacement of selected dock elements (adding rub strips, rollers, and/or encapsulation to piles for pile protection). These improvements would be located at Cape George Marina, Discovery Bay and Strait de Juan de Fuca, Jefferson County, Washington.

### **Your right to appeal**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.


