Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Jimma Dock Replacement (Corps No. NWS-2022-0477), Lake Sammamish, Issaquah, King County, Washington

Dear Thomas Jimma:

On February 8, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Thomas Jimma's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

On July 19, 2023, Thomas Jimma and Ecology agreed to stay the CZM until February 8, 2024.

The proposed work includes the replacement of an existing 329-square foot pier with a new 320-square foot pier and installation of a new freestanding boatlift. All piles would be removed and placed by the vibratory method. All materials would be brought to the site by barge, and a containment boom would be placed around the work area prior to construction. This activity will occur in Lake Sammamish, Issaquah, King County, Washington.

### **Your right to appeal**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
