Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Trellis Townhomes project, Snohomish County, Washington. The following required processing dates are listed below:

- On April 4, 2023, Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On May 12, 2023, Ecology received a request for Clean Water Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On May 31, 2023, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent an email notification to Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under Nationwide Permit No. 14 and requires an individual Section 401.
- On June 13, 2023, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to construct 50 townhomes on the western portion of the property, along with associated roads and utilities. Road frontage improvements along Ash Way will require the filling of 99 ft² of Wetland B and 3,015 ft² of its buffer. This will be mitigated by purchasing 0.143 credits at the Keller Farm mitigation bank.

The project site is a vacant lot located south of 16717 Alderwood Mall Parkway, in Snohomish County. This property is within Section 11, Township 27 N., and Range 4 E. This area is within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 8-Cedar/Sammamish basin.

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting with conditions Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC's (Nicole Benert) request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Trellis Townhomes project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality

Certification request and attachments Ecology received on May 12, 2023, and the following supporting documentation:

- 1. Joint Aquatic Resources Permit Application (JARPA) and drawings, prepared by Wetland Resources, received on November 20, 2023.
- 2. Wetland delineation report, dated March 15, 2023, prepared by Wetland Resources, and received on May 12, 2023.
- 3. Mitigation Bank Use Plan for Alderwood Mall Parkway Townhomes, prepared by Wetland Resources, and revised on November 17, 2023.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

Wetland Mitigation Conditions

- 1. Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) shall mitigate wetland impacts as described in the Mitigation Bank Use Plan for Alderwood Mall Parkway Townhomes, prepared by Wetland Resources, dated November 17, 2023, or as required by this Order.
 - Justification Alteration of water quality necessitates the use of mitigation as a
 method of controlling pollution. When adequate mitigation is provided, the impacts
 are not considered significant enough to water quality, at least in the long-term. The
 water quality standards, along with mitigation, protect wetlands as well as permitting
 some level of degradation where unavoidable or necessary.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.

- 2. Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) shall submit to Ecology a Statement of Sale from the Keller Farm Mitigation Bank verifying the purchase of 0.143 credits for this impact project. This documentation must include the Ecology Order Number, Order issuance date, impact acreage, the amount of credits required by the Order, and date of credit purchase.
 - Justification This condition is necessary to ensure the compensatory mitigation was actually provided by the in-lieu-fee program.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii) and WAC 173-201A-300.
- 3. Unless otherwise authorized by this Order, Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) shall complete the purchase of credits before impacting wetlands. Otherwise, Ecology may require the Project Proponent to provide additional compensation to account for additional temporal loss of wetland functions.
 - Justification Mitigation that is not emplaced concurrent with impacts will result in degradation of existing beneficial uses of the wetlands affected by the proposed action through temporal loss of functions.
 - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 4. Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) shall obtain and comply with conditions of the Construction Stormwater General Permit (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System NPDES) issued for this project.
 - Justification Ecology must protect waters of the state from all discharges and potential discharges of pollution that can affect water quality to protect aquatic life and beneficial uses.
 - Citation 40 CFR 122, Chapter 90.48 RCW, RCW 90.48.030, RCW 90.48.080, RCW 90.48.260, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-300 330, WAC 173-204-120, and WAC 173-225-010.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260, Chapter 173-200 WAC, and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted with conditions to Pacific Ridge-DRH, LLC (Nicole Benert) for the Trellis Townhomes project.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
