Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Nash Pier (Corps No. NWS-2023-0143), Lake Washington, Bellevue, King County, Washington

Dear Michael Nash:

On August 17, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Michael Nash's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The applicant proposes to enlarge an existing 78 ft² grated pier finger by removing the decking and reframing with a 160 ft² grated pier finger via manual labor. A barge mounted crane will remove one 31 ft² freestanding boatlift with a catwalk and place two 31 ft² boatlifts with grated catwalks.

This activity would occur in Lake Washington, Bellevue, King County, Washington. The project site is located at 9425 Lake Washington Blvd NE; Section 31, Township 25 North, Range 5 East; WRIA 8, Cedar-Sammamish Watershed.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.


