Replacement (Corps No. NWS-2021-0709), Hidden Cove, Bainbridge Island, Kitsap

County, Washington

Dear Bruno and Natalie Latchague:

On April 12, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Bruno and Natalie Latchague's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

On September 26, 2023, Bruno and Natalie Latchague and Ecology agreed to stay the CZM until April 12, 2024, in order for Bruno and Natalie Latchague to obtain a shoreline permit. A shoreline letter of exemption was issued by the City of Bainbridge Island December 18, 2023.

Proposed work includes the removal of an existing ramp, floats, and support piling. Install new ramp, floats, and seven support pilings. A new floating 16-foot by 38-foot boatlift waterward of the High Tide Line (HTL) is no longer proposed. The project is located at 14911 Skogen Lane Northeast, Bainbridge Island in Hidden Cove, Kitsap County, Washington.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
