Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Poulsbo Breakwater Rehabilitation (Corps No. NWS-2019-0682), Liberty Bay, Poulsbo, Kitsap County, Washington

Dear Carol Tripp:

On November 30, 2023, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Port of Poulsbo's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The proposed work includes the replacement of severely deteriorated vertical creosote-pile breakwater and replacement with a new floating breakwater. Finger float transient moorage is proposed to be installed and new floating restroom and Floating Upweller System (FLUPSY) is proposed to be moored on new breakwater. This activity is within Liberty Bay at 18809 Front Street Northeast, Poulsbo, Kitsap County, Washington.

### **Your right to appeal**

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.


