On November 10, 2023, Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Sunrise Village Housing, Cowlitz County, Washington.

<b>Site Location</b>	Sunrise Village Housing project located within Wetlands A, B, C, and D, Longview, Cowlitz County, Washington.

Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the Sunrise Village Housing project, Cowlitz County, Washington. The following required processing dates are referenced below:

- On August 2, 2023, the Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On August 16, 2023 the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent an email notification to Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under Nationwide Permit No. 29 and requires an individual Section 401.
- On November 10, 2023, Ecology received a request for a Clean Water Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On November 15, 2023, Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP submitted additional information, and the Department of Ecology (Ecology) considered the Request valid on this date.
- On November 20, 2023, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.

This project proposes to discharge up to 6,220 cubic yards of locally sourced fill within 0.48 acre of Wetlands, A, B, C, and D to construct multi-family housing. The proposed project includes the construction of a building for a low-income housing facility with associated landscaping, parking, and other needed amenities. Compensatory mitigation for wetland impacts will be provided through purchase of mitigation bank credits from the Coweeman River Mitigation Bank.

The project site is located at 3808 Pennsylvania Street, Wetlands A, B, C, and D, Cowlitz County, Washington, Section 19, Township 8 N., Range 2W., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 25 Grays-Elochoman.

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting with conditions Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP's request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the Sunrise Village Housing project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on November 10, 2023.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves the Applicant from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

**Special Conditions:**

1. The Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP shall mitigate wetland impacts as described in Bank Use Plan, prepared by Ecological Land Services LLC, dated June 30, 2023, or as required by this Order.
  - Justification - Alteration of water quality necessitates the use of mitigation as a method of controlling pollution. When adequate mitigation is provided, the impacts are not considered significant enough to water quality, at least in the long-term. The water quality standards, along with mitigation, protect wetlands as well as permitting some level of degradation where unavoidable or necessary.
  - Citation – 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
2. The Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP shall submit to Ecology documentation from the bank sponsor verifying the purchase of 0.409 wetland mitigation bank credits (credits) from the Coweeman River Mitigation Bank. This documentation must include the Ecology Order Number, Order issuance date, impact acreage, the amount of credits required by the Order, and date of credit purchase.

- Justification - This condition is necessary to ensure the compensatory mitigation was actually provided by the bank.
  - Citation – 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
3. Unless otherwise authorized by this WQC Order, the Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP shall complete the purchase of credits before impacting wetlands. Otherwise, Ecology may require the Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP to provide additional compensation to account for additional temporal loss of wetland functions.
- Justification - Mitigation that is not emplaced concurrent with impacts will result in degradation of existing beneficial uses of the wetlands affected by the proposed action through temporal loss of functions.
  - Citation – 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted with conditions to the Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP for the Sunrise Village Housing project.

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. WQC Order No. **22460** will remain valid for the duration of the associated DA permit. Sunrise Village Housing, LLLP should send a copy of the final DA permit to [fednotification@ecy.wa.gov](mailto:fednotification@ecy.wa.gov) within two weeks of receiving it.

## Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. “Date of receipt” is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing information below). “Filing” means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. “Notice of appeal” is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC
