#### Dear Robert Wolford:

On July 2, 2024, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Bobby Wolford Trucking & Demolition, Inc.'s determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The proposed work involves restoring the hydrologic connection to an oxbow of the Skykomish River, reconnect and restore the natural stream flow of a small tributary stream on the site, and restore connection with the wetlands located on the project site. This will be accomplished by removing approximately 12,093 cubic yards of fill from wetlands and waters and approximately 31,693 cubic yards of fill from uplands; recontouring the land; removing culverts; and constructing at-grade crossings, channel daylighting, and riparian plantings.

The project site is located at 25231 Ben Howard Road, along the Skykomish River, Snohomish County, Washington, Section 3, Township 27 North, Range 7 East, within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 07 – Snohomish.

## Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
