Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Bright Shoreline

Stabilization (Corps No. NWS-2024-593), Port Susan, Camano Island, Island County,

Washington

Dear Anthony Bright:

On November 12, 2024, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Ecology issued a 21-day public notice on November 27, 2024. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Anthony Bright's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The proposed work includes removing an existing 46-foot-long existing timber bulkhead and replacing it with a 46-foot-long concrete bulkhead. The replacement cast in-place concrete bulkhead face would be installed approximately 6 inches to a foot landward of the existing bulkhead face, aside from the outward-curving splash cap. All replacement bulkhead work would be conducted in the dry during low tides. The existing bulkhead would first be removed, and then temporary concrete forms would be installed for the replacement structure. Concrete forms would remain for a minimum of seven days to allow concrete to cure prior to tidal inundation or contact with surface water. All beach depressions would be regraded prior to the next inundating tide. This activity is located at 3171 Shoreline Drive in Camano Island, within Port Susan, Island County, Washington.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology by mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
