On January 27, 2025, East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the 44<sup>th</sup> Street Northeast PRD, Snohomish County, Washington.

On behalf of the state of Washington, the Department of Ecology certifies with conditions that the work described in the Water Quality Certification Request and supplemental documents complies with applicable provisions of Sections 301, 302, 303, 306, and 307 of the Clean Water Act, as amended, and applicable state laws. # In The Matter of Granting a Water Quality Certification with Conditions to East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401), RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 and Chapter 173-201A WAC

East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) submitted a request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) under the federal Clean Water Act for the 44<sup>th</sup> Street Northeast PRD, Snohomish County, Washington. The required processing dates are listed below:

- On 11/21/2024, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) sent an email notification to Ecology that they are reviewing the project for authorization under the Nationwide Permit (NWP) Program.
- On 11/25/2024, the East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) submitted a pre-filing meeting request.
- On 1/27/2025, Ecology received a request for Clean Water Section 401 Water Quality Certification.
- On 2/11/2025, Ecology issued a public notice for the project.
- Ecology's "Reasonable Period of Time" for this project has been established as 7/26/2025.

This project proposes a residential development of 61 townhomes with internal access roads and stormwater infrastructure. Utility and stormwater infrastructure will be installed immediately following installation of temporary erosion and sediment control (TESC) measures. The site will be cleared of existing buildings and associated infrastructure and grading and site preparation will be completed. The City of Marysville is requiring frontage improvements and the extension of 44th Street Northeast along the northern property boundary. This roadway extension will require the fill of Wetland A (7,585 ft²), which will be compensated through the purchase of 0.174-acre credits from the Snohomish Basin Mitigation Bank.

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The project site is located at 4229, 4305, and 4333 83rd Avenue NE, Wetland A, Snohomish County, Washington, Section 1, Township 29 N., Range 5 E., within Water Resource Inventory Area (WRIA) 7 - Snohomish

With this WQC Order, Ecology is granting with conditions East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid)'s request for a Section 401 Water Quality Certification for the 44<sup>th</sup> Street Northeast PRD project, provided that the activity is conducted in accordance with the Section 401 Water Quality Certification request and attachments Ecology received on 1/27/2025.

Based on the information submitted, Ecology has determined that the discharge from the project will comply with state water quality requirements. Prior to undertaking any changes that materially alter the project, East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) must contact Ecology to determine whether a new Section 401 Water Quality Certification is required.

Issuance of this Section 401 Water Quality Certification for this proposal does not authorize East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) to exceed applicable state water quality standards (Chapter 173-201A WAC), ground water quality standards (Chapter 173-200 WAC), or sediment quality standards (Chapter 173-204 WAC). Furthermore, nothing in this Section 401 Water Quality Certification absolves East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) from liability for contamination and any subsequent cleanup of surface waters, ground waters, or sediments resulting from project construction or operations.

#### **Special Conditions:**

- This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project and will remain valid until December 31, 2026.
  - Justification Certifications are required for any license or permit that authorizes an
    activity that may result in a discharge or fill material into waters. This WQC Order is
    not valid until the Federal agency issues a permit. Additionally, Ecology needs to be
    able to specify how long the WQC Order will be in effect.
  - Citation Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, and WAC 173-225-010.
- East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall send a copy of the final Federal permit via e-mail to <u>fednotification@ecy.wa.gov</u> and cc to <u>doug.gresham@ecy.wa.gov</u> prior to the starting of any work authorized by this WQC Order. If the Federal Agency determines the proposed project does not require a Federal permit, the East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall immediately inform Ecology.

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> Justification - This condition is needed to ensure that the federal permit has been issued and all the conditions of the WQC Order have been included into the federal permit.

- Citation 40 CFR 121.10, 40 CFR 121.11, and Chapter 90.48 RCW.
- 3. To transfer this WQC Order to a new owner or operator East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall:
  - a. Complete a Request for Transfer of Order with a specific transfer date of the WQC Order's obligations, coverage, and liability and submit it to Ecology at <a href="mailto:fednotification@ecy.wa.gov">fednotification@ecy.wa.gov</a> and cc to <a href="mailto:doug.gresham@ecy.wa.gov">doug.gresham@ecy.wa.gov</a>.   - b. Provide a copy of this WQC Order to the new owner or operator; and
  - c. The transfer is not considered valid until East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) receives written notification from Ecology that the transfer has been approved.
    - Justification Ecology has independent state authority to ensure protection of state water quality. Ecology needs to ensure that anyone conducting work at the project, including any new owners or operators, are aware of and understand the required conditions of this WQC Order to ensure compliance with the water quality standards and other applicable state laws.
    - Citation 40 CFR 121.5, Chapter 90.48 RCW, RCW 90.48.030, Chapter 173-201A WAC, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 5. East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall mitigate wetland impacts as described in Bank Use Plan for 44<sup>th</sup> Street Northeast PRD, prepared by Soundview Consultants, dated October 7, 2024 (hereafter called the "Mitigation Plan"), or as required by this Order.
  - Justification Alteration of water quality necessitates the use of mitigation as a
    method of controlling pollution. When adequate mitigation is provided, the impacts
    are not considered significant enough to water quality, at least in the long-term. The
    water quality standards, along with mitigation, protect wetlands as well as
    permitting some level of degradation where unavoidable or necessary.
  - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.

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6. East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall submit to Ecology documentation from the bank sponsor verifying the purchase of 0.174 wetland mitigation bank credits (credits) from the Snohomish Basin Mitigation Bank. This documentation must include the Ecology Order Number, Order issuance date, impact acreage, the amount of credits required by the Order, and date of credit purchase.

- Justification This condition is necessary to ensure the compensatory mitigation was actually provided by the bank.
- Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 7. Unless otherwise authorized by this WQC Order, East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall complete the purchase of credits before impacting wetlands. Otherwise, Ecology may require East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) to provide additional compensation to account for additional temporal loss of wetland functions.
  - Justification Mitigation that is not emplaced concurrent with impacts will result in degradation of existing beneficial uses of the wetlands affected by the proposed action through temporal loss of functions.
  - Citation 33 CFR 332, 40 CFR 131.12, 40 CFR 230, subpart J, RCW 47.85.040, Chapter 90.48 RCW, Chapter 90.54 RCW, Chapter 90.74 RCW, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-260 (3)(i-ii), WAC 173-201A-300, and WAC 173-225-010.
- 8. East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) shall obtain and comply with the conditions of the Construction Stormwater General Permit (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System NPDES) issued for this project.
  - Justification Ecology must protect waters of the state from all discharges and potential discharges of pollution that can affect water quality to protect aquatic life and beneficial uses.
  - Citation Chapter 90.48 RCW, RCW 90.48.030, RCW 90.48.080, RCW 90.48.260, Chapter 173-201A WAC, WAC 173-201A-300 - 330, WAC 173-204-120, and WAC 173-225-010.

In view of the foregoing and in accordance with 33 U.S.C. §1341, RCW 90.48.120, RCW 90.48.260 Chapter 173-200 WAC and Chapter 173-201A WAC, this WQC is granted with conditions to the East Sound Investors LLC (Michael Reid) for the 44<sup>th</sup> Street Northeast PRD project.

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#### Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology by mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
