Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Zittel's Marina

Maintenance Dredging (Corps No. NWS-2009-1188), Baird Cove, Nisqually Reach,

Olympia, Thurston County, Washington

Dear Jason Zittel:

On May 1, 2025, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. Ecology issued a 21-day public notice on June 13, 2025. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with Zittel's Marina Inc.'s determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The project proposes to conduct maintenance dredging to -10 MLLW plus 1 foot allowable overdredge. Approximately 32,000 cubic yards (CY) are approved for in-water disposal, with approximately 17,500 CY dredged in the initial dredging. Two additional maintenance dredging events of approximately 4,500 CY are allowed within the life of the 10 year permit. The project also includes bulkhead repair and piling removal (18 piles replaced, total of 46 creosote pilings removed).

## Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology by mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
