Re: Coastal Zone Management Federal Consistency Decision for Port of Ilwaco Maintenance Dredging (Corps No. NWP-2004-78-6), Baker Bay, Ilwaco, Pacific County, Washington

Dear Tina Hayes:

On March 7, 2025, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received a Certification of Consistency with the Washington State Coastal Zone Management Program (CZMP) for the above project. A 30-day Joint Public Notice was issued by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Portland District and Ecology on April 15, 2025. Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the Port of Ilwaco's determination that the proposed work is consistent with Washington's CZMP.

The proposed work includes a one-time event to dredge up to 280,288 cubic yards (cy) and annual maintenance dredging of up to 50,000 cy, for a total of up to 735,000 cy over a 10-year period, within the Port of Ilwaco marina. This activity would occur in Baker Bay, Ilwaco, Pacific County, Washington.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this decision on the Department of Ecology by mail, in person, or by email (see addresses below).

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.

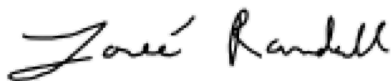
