On March 2, 2021 the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) issued a 401 Water Quality Certification (WQC) to Taylor Shellfish Farms for the above-referenced project pursuant to the provisions of 33 U.S.C. 1341 (FWPCA § 401).

Ecology received a request from Taylor Shellfish Farms on September 17, 2024, to extend the expiration date of this WQC. On April 18, 2025 the Corps agreed that Ecology can modify the WQC as requested by Taylor Shellfish Farms.

WQC Order No. 19659 dated March 2, 2021 is hereby amended as follows:

I. The paragraph on page 2 which reads:

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues a permit for this project. Order No. **19659** will remain in effect for a period of five years from the issuance of the Corps permit.

Is replaced with:

This Certification is not effective until the U.S. Corps of Engineers (Corps) Seattle District issues an individual Department of the Army (DA) permit for this project. Order No. **19659** will remain valid until December 31, 2036. Taylor Shellfish Farms should send a copy of the final DA permit to fednotification@ecy.wa.gov within two weeks of receiving it.

No other conditions or requirements of the above referenced Order are affected by this amendment.

Ecology retains continuing jurisdiction to make modifications hereto through supplemental order, if it appears necessary to further protect the public interest.

Failure to comply with this amended Order may result in the issuance of civil penalties or other actions whether administrative or judicial, to enforce the terms of this amended Order.

Your right to appeal

You have a right to appeal this Order to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Order:

- File your notice of appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see filing information below). "Filing" means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours as defined in WAC 371-08-305 and -335. "Notice of appeal" is defined in WAC 371-08-340.
- Serve a copy of your notice of appeal and this Order on the Department of Ecology, in paper form, by mail, or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
