RE: Federal Consistency Concurrence for the Keystone Harbor Dredging Project in Island County, Washington

Dear Chief Boerner:

On January 28, 2020, the Seattle Branch of the Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) sent the Department of Ecology (Ecology) a Consistency Determination (CD) for the Keystone Harbor Dredging Project. The project consists of maintenance dredging of up to 165,000 cubic yards of material in Keystone Harbor on the west side of Whidbey Island. The work will occur over a 15-year period during the approved work windows between July 16 and February 15. All the dredged material will be applied as a beneficial use to nourish the beach east of the breakwater. The project is in Island County, Washington.

Pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the USACE's determination that the proposed project is consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the Washington CZMP. The project triggers the enforceable policies found in the state Shoreline Management Act, and the USACE opted to demonstrate compliance with those policies by analyzing the Island County Shoreline Master Program. Ecology issued a Section 401 WQ Certification on March 18, 2020, which satisfied the requirement that the project be consistent with the state Water Pollution Control Act's enforceable policies.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
