RE: Federal Consistency Concurrence for Browns Point Lighthouse Repairs in Tacoma, Washington

Dear Laura Delgado:

On December 14, 2020, the Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology) received the United States Coast Guard's (USCG) Consistency Determination for the above project. The project's purpose of the project is to repair and preserve the Browns Point Lighthouse not only as a historic icon of Tacoma, but also as an element of the publicly-accessible Browns Point Lighthouse Park. The project would repair or replicate features integral to the structure's Art Deco design, abate lead based paint on the exterior, repaint the exterior, and rebuild the staircase.

Ecology acknowledges and agrees with the USCG's assessment that the project has minimal effects on Washington's coastal uses and resources. Thus, pursuant to Section 307(c)(3) of the Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972 as amended, Ecology concurs with the USCG's determination that the proposed project is consistent to the maximum extent practicable with the Washington Coastal Zone Management Program.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this decision to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2)

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this decision: File your appeal and a copy of this decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.


Serve a copy of your appeal and this decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person.
