# **Areas Excluded from Soil Cleanup**



This handout lists the areas that are excluded from soil removal in the Yard Sampling and Cleanup Program. We cannot clean up areas of the yard that are hard to reach, could create hazards, and where possible exposure is low. County or city ordinances may also exclude an area from cleanup.

#### **Permanent Structures**

Ecology cannot cleanup or sample under permanent structures, where we cannot access soil.

- Buildings with foundations
- Decks with limited access underneath (less than three feet)
- Pools/hot tubs, or structures that can not be moved
- Temporary structures that the homeowner is not willing to move, such as animal kennels, lawn equipment, tool sheds



## **Concrete or other cap materials**

Ecology will not cleanup or sample under concrete, asphalt, pavers or other cap materials.


- Driveways
- Sidewalks
- **Patios**
- Parking structures

# **Permanent Landscaping**

Ecology will not cleanup or sample areas under permanent landscape structures.


- Retaining walls
- Rock walls
- Terraces
- Rock gardens



# Large trees, bushes or shrubs.

Ecology will not cleanup within the drip line or root ball of large trees, bushes or shrubs. If a homeowner would like cleanup near a bush or shrub, they must remove the plant themselves to allow access to the soil.


- Forested Areas
- Bushes that must remain in place during cleanup.



## **Steep slopes**

Ecology will not cleanup soil above, on, or below steep slopes. We have to meet county development standards for steep slopes.


- Slopes greater than 33% slope
- Slopes greater than 10 feet high



# **Aquatic Features**

Ecology will not cleanup or sample in, around or under aquatic features.


- Wetlands
- **Ponds**
- Streams or creeks
- Beaches



# **Underground tanks/drainfields**

Ecology will not cleanup above or right next to underground tanks or drainfields.


- Septic Systems
- Home heating oil tanks



#### **Livestock Areas**

Ecology will not cleanup or sample in, around or under livestock areas.

- Barns
- Sheds
- Corrals
- **Pastures**
