

**STATE ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT
DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

Proposed Action: Agreed Order No. DE 16299

Description of proposal: Tesoro Refining & Marketing Company LLC currently operates an oil refinery in Anacortes, Washington. Ecology is proposing to enter into an agreed order with Tesoro requiring Tesoro to inspect the integrity of their oily water sewer for releases or potential releases to soil and groundwater. If releases or potential releases are found, Tesoro will conduct remedial actions to reduce exposure pathways for waste constituents at the site. Actions include correcting the cause of the release or potential release, excavating contaminated soils where possible, extracting or treating contaminated groundwater, and groundwater monitoring.
