Dear Bill Preston and Scott Schafer:

The Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) is writing to inform you that minor changes in the Scope of Work (SOW) are required for the Amended Consent Decree No. 02-2-00956-2. Halogenated volatile organic compounds (HVOCs) were discovered in groundwater samples obtained by your consultant beginning in May 2020, and continue to be present in site groundwater after additional monitoring events.


Ecology and the City of Yakima have agreed to minor changes to the work to be performed according to Section XV. Amendment of Consent Decree, paragraph one. This minor change in the SOW will allow for fieldwork to be conducted in order to determine whether or not the HVOCs are entering the site groundwater from the west. This minor change shall also allow for use of Remedial Action Grant funds toward performing the minor change in SOW.
