Dear Tasya Gray and Scott Hooton:

The purpose of this letter is to provide documentation of the Department of Ecology's (Ecology) Informal Dispute Decision<sup>1</sup> as requested by the Agreed Order (AO) Parties (General Metals of Tacoma, Inc., Occidental Chemical Corporation, and Burlington Environmental LLC).<sup>2</sup>

## **Background**

Ecology received the Informal Dispute Notice from the Agreed Order (AO) Parties (General Metals of Tacoma, Inc., Occidental Chemical Corporation, and Burlington Environmental LLC) on April 9, 2021.<sup>3</sup> The AO Parties also previously sent a letter requesting that Ecology waive portions of Invoice #1 costs because the AO Parties considered them to only pertain to the

enforcement Order (EO) Party (Port of Tacoma).<sup>4</sup> On April 23, 2021, Ecology met with the AO and EO Project Coordinators (Tasya Gray and Scott Hooton, respectively). Rob Healy, Port of Tacoma, and Nick Acklam, Ecology also attended the meeting. In the meeting, Ecology described which costs would be credited and shared a summary table that detailed these costs. This table was emailed to the attendees following the meeting.<sup>5</sup>

## **AO Parties Request and Ecology Response**

In their April 29 letter, the AO Parties requested four items from Ecology. These are listed below, followed by Ecology's response:

 a) Confirm Ecology's receipt of \$145,365.99 from the AO Parties in full and timely payment of Ecology Invoices #1 and #2 (and confirm Ecology's credit of those payments to the AO).

<u>Ecology response</u>: Below is a table that shows the payments that have received from the AO and EO Parties. A revised Invoice #1 that includes the amount that Ecology will be crediting was sent to the AO and EO project coordinators via email on May 25.<sup>6</sup> Therefore, the revised total amount due for Invoices #1 and #2 is \$143,900.22. Since the amount paid to date is \$138,286.66, the amount of \$5,613.56 for Invoice #2 is still owed to Ecology.

As stated by Ecology during the April 23 meeting with the AO and EO project coordinators, Ecology will not allocate costs between the AO and EO Parties. Invoices are sent to both the AO and EO Parties and it is up to the Parties to decide how the invoices will be paid. Because the work to be performed for the AO and EO is common and shared, there is no separation of Ecology oversight costs between the AO and EO.

b) Confirm Ecology's receipt of \$21,238.02 from the Port as a late partial payment on Invoice #1 (received by Ecology several weeks after the Invoice #1 payment was due)(and confirm Ecology's credit of that payment to the AO).

<u>Ecology Response</u>: A total of \$21,238 has been received from the Port of Tacoma as shown in the above table.

c) Confirm the amount of credit Ecology proposes to issue to the AO Parties for the disputed costs included in Invoices #1 and #2.

<u>Ecology Response</u>: No separate credit will be issued to the AO Parties since Ecology is not allocating costs between the AO and EO Parties. As shown in the May 25 revised invoices, Ecology is crediting a total of \$1,465.77 on Invoice #1. These credits are detailed on the attached table. The reason these costs were credited is because they were not applicable to the TWAAFA Site investigation and/or administrative order negotiation. No Invoice #2 costs will be credited since the costs on this invoice are valid TWAAFA Site costs.

d) Confirm the rationale for Ecology's conclusion that other costs at issue in the Dispute should not be subject to credit as requested by the AO Parties.

Ecology Response: See above responses and attached table.
