Thank you for submitting the results of your independent remarkal action for review by the State of Washington Department of Ecology (Ecology). Exclosive appreciates your initiative in pursuing this administrative option under the Model toxics Control Act (MTCA).

Ecology's Toxics Cleanup Program has reviewed the following information regarding the Former Southgate Oil, 23428 Pacific Highway South Kint:

- 1. Progress Site Assessment, propare by Nowicki & Associates, Inc. / May 3, 2001.
- 2. Underground Storage Tank Decommissioning and Soil Remediation Project, prepared to Sound Environmental Strategies, Corp. / February 25, 2002.

The reports listed above will be kept in the Central Files of the Northwest Regional Office (NWRO) of Ecology of Lev by appointment only. Appointments can be made by calling Sally Per institute NWRO at (425) 649-7190.

Based upon the information in the report(s), Ecology has determined that, at this time, the release of diesel-range hydrocarbons into the soil within the property boundary no longer poses a timeat to human health or the environment.

The core, Ecology is issuing this determination that no further remedial action is necessary at this site under MTCA, chapter 70.105D RCW. However, please note that use your actions were not conducted under a consent decree with Ecology, this letter is written pursuant to RCW 70.105D030(1)(i) and does not constitute a settlement under RCW 70.105D.040(4) and is not binding to Ecology.

Ecology's "No Further Action" determination is made only with respect to the release identified in the reports listed in the reports above. This "No Further Action" determination applies to soil only within the property boundary of the Former Southgate Oil, 23428 Pacific Highway South, Kent. Diesel-range petroleum hydrocarbon soils exist along the northern property boundary of the subject property off-site beneath a paved alley.

Ecology will update its database to reflect this "No Further Action" determination for soil only within the property boundary of the Former Southgate Oil, 23428 Pacific Highway South, Kent. Your site will continue to appear in future publications of the Confirmed and Suspected Contaminated Sites Report (previously known as the Affected Media and Contaminants Report) and the Leaking Underground Storage Tank List.
