On behalf of the Port of Skagit (the Port), this letter serves as a progress report for the third quarter of 2019 for the former Northern State Multi Service Center Site (the Site), located at 2070 Northern State Road in Sedro-Woolley, Washington. This report fulfills the progress reporting requirement specified in Section VII of Agreed Order No. DE 16309 (Agreed Order).

## **PROJECT STATUS**

- On September 3, 2019, the Port received a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for \$395,000 to support community involvement at the Site and remedial design and implementation of interim cleanup actions at two areas of concern (AOCs); the former laundry building and arsenic in soil.
- A kickoff meeting to discuss the project with the Port, USEPA, and Ecology representatives has been scheduled for November 7<sup>th</sup> in Seattle, Washington.

## **ON-SITE FIELD ACTIVITIES**

There were no on-site activities during the reporting period.

## **DEVIATIONS FROM REQUIRED TASK**

There were no deviations from required tasks during the reporting period.

## **DEVIATIONS FROM SCOPE OF WORK, SCHEDULE, AND CLEANUP ACTION PLAN**

A 60-day extension was requested by the Port to complete the following deliverables outlined in the Agreed Order:

- Remedial Investigation Work Plan

- Interim Action Cleanup Action Report and Engineering Design: AOC 1, Former Laundry Building
- Interim Action Cleanup Action Report and Engineering Design: AOC 4, Arsenic in Soil

The extension was requested as a result of conditions related to the site that were beyond the Port's control, including changing redevelopment plans and timelines associated with the former Laundry Building (AOC 1).

The proposed extended deadline for these deliverables is now December 13, 2019.

There was no data generated during the reporting period.

## **UPCOMING DELIVERABLES AND DEADLINES**


