



## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal:** An interim action consisting of removal of approximately 50 cubic yards of petroleum contaminated soil and monitoring of groundwater at this property. The property was the site of a historic gas station. The underground storage tanks were removed in calendar year 2000 and contaminated soil was identified but left in place.

**Proponents:** Washington State Department of Ecology
