Arcadis U.S., Inc. requests approval from the Washington State Department of Ecology (Ecology) to abandon the 33 monitoring wells associated with the Kinder Morgan Harbor Island Facility (facility) presented on the attached figure. These wells are not a part of the performance monitoring well network outlined in the Compliance Monitoring Plan (Exhibit F of the 2000 Consent Decree between Ecology and GATX Terminals) and are not necessary for facility groundwater monitoring activities. There are a total of 22 "chip in place" wells (19 with construction logs, 3 with variance) and 11 over-drill wells that we propose to abandon. Holt Services, the drilling contractor, will provide a notice of intent to decommission all wells a minimum of 72-hours prior to initiating work, in accordance with WAC 173-160-420.


