Attached is a permit to dispose of petroleum contaminated soil (PCS) at the Richland landfill. This soil, approximately 140 cubic yards in volume, was excavated during removal and remediation of an underground fuel storage site at the City of Benton City maintenance shop yard. The shop yard is on land owned by the Union Pacific Railroad and leased to Benton City. Benton City is the responsible owner of the PCS. Attached is a December 23, 1992 letter to Mr. Mike Peloquin, Benton Franklin Health Dept., which includes sample test results. Also attached is a letter from Mr. Mike Peloquin to yourself concerning this project.
