Ecology concurs with Simplot's request to postpone the soil vapor extraction (SVE implementation) until spring of 2022, due to the end of the warm season and lower anticipated EDB soil volatilization rate during the cold season. Please provide Ecology with a written plan on how the soil stock piles will be protected from weather, wind, and unauthorized access until Site field work starts up again in spring 2022.
