



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Gilbert and Robertson Elementary Schools Interim Remedial Actions consist of excavating and hauling away some soil contaminated with lead and arsenic for disposal at a permitted landfill, mixing remaining soil, importing clean soil, and establishing new grass in this clean soil. The plan at each school includes installation of an irrigation system to maintain the turf cover.

Proponents: Washington State Department of Ecology
