



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: An environmental cleanup of the Bee Jay Scales Site in the City of Sunnyside. The remedial action includes a combination of soil excavation, in situ bioremediation injection wells/borings (for delivering sodium acetate solution or calcium acetate), institutional controls, monitored natural attenuation, and construction of vertical barrier wall treatment system or other Ecology-approved treatment method for the off-Property groundwater plume attributable to the Bee-Jay Scales Site.

Proponents: Washington Department of Ecology

Location of proposal, including street address if any: In the city of Sunnyside, Parcel No. 22102522014, located at 116 North 1st Street, Sunnyside; and Parcel No. 22102522015, located at 301 Warehouse Avenue, Sunnyside.

Lead agency: Washington Department of Ecology
