

## DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

**Description of proposal**: An environmental cleanup of the Bee Jay Scales Site in the City of Sunnyside. The remedial action includes a combination of soil excavation, in situ bioremediation injection wells/borings (for delivering sodium acetate solution or calcium acetate), institutional controls, monitored natural attenuation, and construction of vertical barrier wall treatment system or other Ecology-approved treatment method for the off-Property groundwater plume attributable to the Bee-Jay Scales Site.
