The Department of Ecology herein approves Annual Compliance Monitoring Report (November 2019 Through August 2020) Terminal 91 Tank Farm Affected Area Seattle, Washington (2020 Annual CMR) prepared by Pacific Groundwater Group (PGG) dated October 30, 2020. The 2020 Annual CMR was received by Ecology on October 30, 2020, via email. This report was submitted in accordance with Ecology/Port of Seattle (POS) Agreed Order 8938 and Port of Seattle 2013 Compliance Monitoring Plan (CMP) and Operation and Maintenance Plan (OMP). This report is approved with the following comments:

- 1. This was year five of Performance Monitoring conducted in accordance with the CMP. After careful review and analysis of five years of data, the POS has recommended adjustments to the monitoring program. Ecology has reviewed the data and the analyses conducted by Pacific Groundwater Group, and herein approves the recommended reduction of selected wells and analytes from the monitoring program.
- 2. Page 13, section 6.5.2, paragraph 1 refers to Table 8. There is no table 8.
- 3. Page 13, section 6.5.2, paragraph CP-GP01B needs to be removed from this list of "wells to be removed". CP-GP01B shall remain as a conditional point of compliance well and be monitored for TPH.
- 4. Table 7, Well number CP-GP01B is a conditional point of compliance (CPOC) well and should be listed under "CPOC Wells" in table 7.
