On behalf of the Volland Estate (Estate) and the Estate's legal counsel, Aspect Consulting, LLC (Aspect) has prepared this response to Washington State Department of Ecology's (Ecology) November 12, 2021, Voluntary Cleanup Program (VCP) site status request. On January 10, 2020, Aspect and the Estate's legal counsel convened a meeting with Ecology to discuss VCP site status, the practicality of future remediation, and a recommended path forward in preparation of submitting a Focused Feasibility Study. It was agreed upon at this meeting that the Focused Feasibility Study would include a Work Plan for a soil gas investigation and vapor intrusion evaluation. Since the January 2020 meeting, Aspect has been working on budgeting, scoping, and planning the soil gas investigation. The tentative schedule going forward is to provide Ecology with a draft Focused Feasibility Study Report containing the Work Plan during the first quarter of 2022. The soil gas investigation is also planned for 2022.

We appreciate Ecology's patience on this project and we look forward to continuing to work through the VCP program.
